WHAT IS A WISP (WIRELESS INTERNET SERVICE PROVIDER)

Forrestrial Based, Fixed Wireless

Compete with Telcos (DSL, T-1s), Cable Companies, Mobile Carriers Data plans, and Satellite providers.

Not a cell phone provider

►Not Wi-Fi

➢ In North Carolina about 27 WISPs...... 100 counties in NC





PUBLIC – PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP NCW EXAMPLES

✓ Avery County, NC:

- Population: 17, 700
- % Population under 18 years of age: 16%
- % Population over 65 years of age: 19.7%
- Involved in forming the Partnership: (Public) County Commissioners, County Economic Development Director, and County Manager: Private: North Carolina Wireless,: Promoted and facilitated by eNC (NC Department of Commerce).
- Less Risk = Higher likelihood of successful project.

✓ City of Claremont, NC

- Population: 1,700
- Physical size, about 3 square miles
- Involved in forming the partnership: (Public) City Council and City Manager: Private: North Carolina Wireless: Promoted and facilitated by eNC (NC Department of Commerce).
